**PROCEEDING OF THE DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 07/06/2019 AT 11-00 AM AT DEPUTY COMMISSIONER'S CONFERENCE HALL, SONITPUR, TEZPUR.**

Sri.Narsing Pawar, IAS Deputy Commissioner, Sonitpur presided over the meeting.

The meeting reviewed the proceeding of the last Dist. Development Committee meeting and the following points were discussed for needful action by the concerned departments.

**(1) Assam Power Dist. Cor. Ltd (APDCL):-**

The Chairman asked AGM about the electricity coverage in Sonitpur district under DDUGJY. The AGM appraised that under Deen Dayal Upadhyay Gram Jyoti Yojana (DDUGJY) there is 80% electricity coverage in Sonitpur district. The AGM also appraised that 100% electrification will be done before 31-03-2020. The Chairman directed the AGM to expedite the progress of DDUGJY. A separate meeting will be held on this matter.

**(2) Public Health Engineering Department :-**

The EE, PHE appraised that four PWSS schemes have been chosen as pilot project for handing over to the PRIs. Before handing over the schemes in July, 2019 a joint visit with PRI members would be undertaken within 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2019. The EE, PHE appraised that they have received new IEC fund and GP wise awareness meeting will be organised. The EE also informed that 100% Geo-tagging and ODF in rural area have been completed.

**(3) Fisheries Department:**

The DFDO appraised that 145 beneficiaries out of 645 individual beneficiaries have already been received the 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment for the scheme "Ghare Ghare Pukhuri Ghare Ghare Maach" (GGPGGM). DDM, NABARD has suggested that Awareness Programme to be undertaken in Singri and Borsola area as there is scope to increase fish production in that area. He also requested DFDO to encourage the fish farmers for availing KCC loan. The Chairman directed the DFDO and District Dairy Dev. Officer to take steps for constituting Co-Operative Societies. The District Deputy Registrar of Co-Operative Societies will also take initiative for registration. The Chairman also suggested that the Deptt should submit proposal to the Govt. for filling up the vacant post with a copy to the Deputy Commissioner.

**(4) Agriculture Department:**

The DAO, Agriculture Deptt informed that they have completed the distribution of remaining 5,706 Soil Health Cards. The DAO appraised that the list of 1068 beneficiaries of PM-KISHAN scheme (2<sup>nd</sup> phase) have already been uploaded. The selection process for tractor distribution is yet to complete for the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase. The DAO appraised that they have already

discussed with the farmers to conserve local variety of paddy, brinjal, chilli etc. The DAO informed that the posts of 70% field workers are lying vacant at present. The Deputy Commissioner instructed the DAO to submit a proposal of vacancy of the field worker to the Govt. The chairman also instructed to take initiative for the farmers' incentive schemes. The Chairman directed EE, PWD (Roads) to submit the Progress Report on the road Schemes in Chariduar area under APART.

**(5) Irrigation Department:**

The Executive Engineer, Irrigation Deptt apprised that 7080 hectares of land have been covered by Irrigation Deptt in Sonitpur district and 22 nos of projects can supply water in 3755 hectares of land at present. The EE also informed that the progress of work of Dighalibeel FIS is 97%. In a query, the EE replied that there are 2 nos of DTW schemes in Doomdooma GP but not functioning at present. New proposal has been submitted but yet sanctioned.

**(6) Soil Conservation Department:**

DO, Soil Conservation has informed that the progress and Halleswar and Thelamara IWMP are 93% and 90% respectively.

**(7) Industries Department:**

The representative of GM, DICCC informed that due to non-receipt of subsidy the progress of "SVAYEM" scheme is not satisfactory. The Chairman opined that the matter would be taken up in the next DLCC meeting.

**(8) Water Resources Department:-**

The EE, Water Resources Deptt. apprised that they have submitted the proposal of Jiaboroli Erosion Plan for Rs.4.63 crore to the Govt under SDRF but sanction has not yet received. The Chairman has directed the EE to make a survey of probable point of breach for taking precautionary measures.

**(9) Panchayat & Rural Development Department:**

The CEO, ZP apprised that they have already submitted the proposal to the Govt. for appointment of GP Secretary in each GP where more than one GP is allotted Secretaries. He also informed that the list of landless PMAYG beneficiary has been submitted.

**(10) Food & Civil Supplies and C.A. Department:-**

Dy Director, F&CS informed that "Amar Dukan" scheme is continuing and the progress of PM's "UJJWALA" scheme is 63.5%.

**(11) Health & Family Welfare Department:-**

The Chairman has expressed dissatisfaction on the functioning of the Blood Bank. He also instructed the Dy. Superintendent, TMCH to submit a copy of proposal for the construction of Doctors quarters which has already been submitted to the Govt. The Deputy Commissioner also instructed the Dy. Superintendent, TMCH to organise a review meeting on regular basis at least once.
