**PROCEEDING OF THE DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 04/05/2019 AT 12-00 NOON AT DEPUTY COMMISSIONER'S CONFERENCE HALL, SONITPUR, TEZPUR.**

Sri. Narsing Pawar, IAS Deputy Commissioner, Sonitpur presided over the meeting.

Before starting the deliberations, the District Development Commissioner asked all the members present in the meeting to introduce themselves. District Development Commissioner directed all defaulting HODs to submit report on achievement of present Govt in last 3 years, both in hard & soft copy by 5:00 PM of 04/05/2019.

The meeting reviewed the proceeding of the last Dist. Development Committee meeting and the following points were discussed for needful action by the concerned departments.

**(1) Assam Power Dist. Cor. Ltd (APDCL):-**

The Chairman instructed the AGM, APDCL to take necessary measures immediately to restore electricity after landfall of the cyclone "FANI" in Assam if required. The DC also instructed AGM to furnish status of manpower, if there is any shortage, for smooth functioning of their work. The AGM apprised that they have completed the pending Right of Way (ROW) to Matikhana PWSS.

**(2) Public Health Engineering Department :-**

The EE, PHE apprised that they are to choose two PWSS schemes per Sub-division as pilot project for handing over to the PRIs. The modalities of handing over have not yet been finalized. Regarding SBM(G,) the EE informed that 100% Geo-tagging has been completed and IEC fund is not available at present. 142 users committees are activated out of 196 till date.

**(3) Fisheries Department:**

The Chairman instructed the DFDO to submit a report of "Matsya Samridhi" scheme of Borakata bill within three days. The DFDO, Fishery Deptt informed that they have already drawn the 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment for the scheme "Matsya Jagaran-Ghare Ghare Pukhuri Ghare Ghare Maach" (GGPGGM). He also informed that there are 645 individual beneficiaries in Sonitpur District. DC instructed DFDO to submit a detailed report on status of pending RIDF Schemes, status of GGPGGM(1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment) and Revenue generation etc within 3 days, to this office.

**(4) Agriculture Department:**

The Chairman instructed the DAO, Agriculture Deptt to upload the list of remaining beneficiaries of PM-KISHAN scheme. The DAO informed that they have started the distribution of remaining 5,706 Soil Health Cards and would complete the distribution process within this month. Under CMSGUY

392 tractors were distributed in the 1<sup>st</sup> phase and no instructions have been received for 2<sup>nd</sup> phase. DDC suggested that effort should also be taken for conservation of local variety of seeds.

**(5) Transport Department:**

Discussing the traffic problems, Deputy Commissioner instructed DTO to restrict the plying of overloaded trucks in busy area.

**(6) Irrigation Department:**

The Chairman instructed the Executive Engineer, Irrigation Deptt to submit the detailed status report of schemes in Doomdooma GP area and also of Dighalibeel along with photographs. The EE apprised that 22 projects can supply water in 2755 hectares of land. The Chairman instructed that he would visit some of the irrigation project shortly.

**(7) Soil Conservation Department:**

The Soil Conservation Department apprised that they have completed the following IWMP Schemes through Watershed Committee.

- (i) PMKSY Haleswar- Rs 54.13 Lakh (Batch-III)
- (ii) PMKSY Thelamara -Rs 53.91 Lakh (Batch -III)

The Chairman suggested that the deptt should inform the public about activities of the deptt, to ensure transparency.

**(8) Industries Department:**

The Chairman instructed the GM, DICC to furnish e-mail id & phone nos of the KVIC officials so that they may be invited to attend the DDC meetings. The GM, DICC informed that they have already provided financial support to the 61 nos of beneficiaries out of 735 beneficiaries under "SVAYEM" scheme. Deputy Commissioner expressed his dissatisfaction on the progress and asked to submit report in the next DDC meeting. GM informed that he would personally visit some Bank Branches next week.

**(10) Water Resources Department:-**

The Chairman instructed the EE, Water Resources Deptt. to submit copy of proposal of Jiabhoroli Erosion Plan which has already been submitted to the Govt. The EE informed that Rs 1.80 crore was allotted for the scheme but Administrative Approval has not yet been accorded. The Chairman also directed to collect the list of encroachment in Char-Chapori area.

**(11) Sports Department:**

The Chairman instructed the DSQ to distribute the copies of guidelines of CMSGUY scheme to all PRI members and also to the office of the Deputy Commissioner.
